Authors who wish to write in a journal sisforma can follow the following format :

1. Paper used is A4 size , with a limit of up, down , right and left side respectively of 2.5 cm
2. The title is written with Times New Roman font size 16 pt , with center alignment
3. The author's name and the name of their home institution and email address author authors written under the title , with the new times roman font size 12 pt
4. Abstract written using Times New Roman font size 11 pt , bold , italic and accompanied by keyword
5. Captions written in Times New Roman font size 10 pt bold at the bottom of the image with alignment center
6. Description table is written with Times New Roman font size 10 pt bold at the top of the table with alignment center
